



### Recycling, & Yard Waste Pickup

Friday is the Village's service day for trash, recycling and yard waste pickup. Please have your items to the road by 7 a.m. on Friday morning.

Paper and paper products (mail, magazines, newspapers, etc.), cardboard, glass and plastic products #1, #2, #4-7, excluding foam are recyclable and you can throw them in your bin. They do not have to be sorted. **DO NOT PUT GARBAGE OR RECYCLABLES IN CARDBOARD.** It will not be picked up. The only way cardboard boxes will be picked up is if they are flattened and cut down to 3' by 3'. **DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS FOR RECYCLABLES.**

Yard waste consists of leaves, grass clippings and small branches that can be placed in yard waste bags or in a 35 gallon trash can with a yard waste label. **Yard waste runs the first Friday in April- last Friday in November.**

## Tax Information

2021 Village of St. Charles taxes are payable at the St. Charles Village Office, 110 West Spruce Street, St. Charles, Michigan. Tax payments are accepted daily during office hours, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

The last day to pay taxes without penalty is September 14, 2021. After that date, a penalty is assessed at a rate of 1% per month, beginning with 1% for the last half of September.

Tax statements are NOT automatically sent to your mortgage company or bank. We attempt to send tax information to lending institutions who request the information from us, but the ultimate responsibility to get it to them is yours.

The Village sends out one tax bill a year. This bill will be mailed out July 1st, and is due September 14th.

You will also have a summer and winter township tax. The Village does not have any information regarding township taxes. If you have any questions on your township taxes please contact your township treasurer.

## Brush Removal

The Department of Public Works provides a courtesy service to residents of the Village by allowing "curbside pick-up" of large items not considered yard waste such as logs, branches, and sticks greater than 3 inches in diameter. This service is only available the first full week of the month, April through October. Before placing brush to the curb, please be aware of the Village's brush removal policy;

- All brush must be stacked neatly parallel to the street and should be within two to three feet from the road surface
- Brush piles cannot exceed 8 feet in length
- If you have multiple piles of 8 feet or less, they may not overlap one another
- All brush must be out to the road by 7:30 a.m. on Monday of the first full week of each month. If brush is not out when our crew is in your neighborhood, your brush will not be picked up.
- Brush generated from a clear-cut of a property will not be fully removed. We will remove only one dump truck load per parcel.

## Yard Waste & Brush Drop Off Sites

Monday-Friday during regular business hours Village residents can drop off their lawn and leaf clippings in the spot designated on Entrepreneur Drive next to our DPW barn.

Monday-Friday during regular business hours residents can make an appointment to drop off brush in the spot designated for brush on Entrepreneur Drive which is separate from our yard waste drop off site.
