## Downtown Development Authority Minutes of the Regular Meeting March 4, 2022

Planning Commission and Village Council minutes were accepted and filed.

The Ice Rink was discussed for maintenance and location with no definite decision made. It will be continuously reviewed throughout the summer months.

Donuts, water, and soda were supplied to say thank you to Chairman Delemeester as his service to the DDA comes to a close. A bittersweet moment filled with reflection and memories. Thank you, Jim, for your service to St. Charles and the DDA.
